**ultrasound guidance for peripheral nerve procedures** - bifid median nerve ultrasound guided nerve injections are helpful for delivering the injectate (steroid, anesthetic, saline) close to the nerve. This allows visualization of the procedure in real time. This is helpful to avoid vascular structures. This can be useful with therapeutic injections, peripheral nerve blocks and hydrodissection.

**ultrasound-guided radial nerve block to relieve ...** - we report our experience using ultrasound-guided radial nerve block to relieve radial artery spasm (ras) in two patients after cannulation of the radial artery. case 1 was a 76-yr-old man admitted to our intensive care (icu) in acute respiratory failure two weeks after repair of an open abdominal aortic aneurysm. comorbidities included
